# History of ReSource & the Origin of the Stable Credit

- Mutual credit (sometimes called "multilateral barter" or "credit clearing") is "a term mostly used in the field of complementary currencies to describe a common, usually small-scale, endogenous money system."



# Stable Credit Protocol

- A simple system used to track incoming & outgoing value based on a P2P credit system
- Open sourced in order to allow the networks to grow organically
- Decentralized finance was meant to free those unable to work within the confines of modern finance - our focus is that anyone can have excess and we focus on design, research, and innovation
- We open sourced the protocol to allow for anyone / anywhere to implement these networks, and publish our findings to encourage others to follow suit and launch their own network



# Use cases in the real world

- We have to shift paradigm about it being so black & white in regards to right or wrong
- Marketplaces in the settlements of Kenya, employee benefits in NYC
- International trade to mitigate rise & fall in the global current system
- Create local marketplaces, whilst leveraging their cash coming in in order to supplement & operate on trust within the confines of their locale
- Creating employee benefit programs at zero % interest to allow members to “purchase goods” from their own employee
- Solving the problem of mobile phones utilizing the old way of billing multiple telecom companies over and over in order for their customers to always have service

- Nairobi - Deploying a credit system in the informal settlements around public sanitization in order to allow members acting as employees to utilize credits within their community
- All Women UBI - Universal Basic Income in Uganda
- Employee Benefits - Allowing members of an organization to be issued "gift cards" to their place of employment in order to buy their own goods without paying interest and going into debt
